## **ABOUT EUROPEAN CULTURE COMMONWEALTH**

Religious and socio-political events were not only the background of trends in architecture and art, but often inspired them or influenced the direction in which they evolved.

Art, including architecture, understood as a means of transmitting ideas influencing the way they are understood, often inspired changes in the way they were received, becoming a mute world of all their complexity.

For a proper understanding of art, one must understand the historical context appropriate to the moment of its creation.

The uniqueness of architectural monuments consists in perpetuating in one work the ideas of people who have left their mark on them over the centuries.

## **CONFERENCE SUBJECT**

The Conference EuCuComm 2019 aims to enable understanding of mutual relations between historical and social events and their reflection of art, including architecture, by presenting various points of view on the processes shaping the contemporary image of Europe's wider cultural heritage.

A great example of the interpenetration and complementation of mutual relations and influences on the European scale is the area of the Silesian-Saxon-Czech borderland, largely coinciding with today's Polish-Czech-German border, and the events taking place there and their reflection in art.

Border and escape churches, the history of their creation and transformations are a great example of mutual coupling of material and non-material factors, affecting their various perception by their contemporaries and present inhabitants of the borderland and Upper Lusatia regions.

- Remarks and Conclusion

The abstract should be clear, aiming at giving a general overview of the paper. Submissions will be peer reviewed by the Scientific Committee of the Conference.

Technical tour (6<sup>th</sup> September 2019) will take place along historical Silesia-Saxony border on the Upper Lusatia region.


## ACCOMMODATION
